Welcome to the St. Luke's Sunday Night Al-Anon and Al-Anon Adult Children Meeting! We meet at St. Luke's Lutheran Church, 4205 Washtenaw Avenue, Ann Arbor (east of Carpenter Road, on the north side of Washtenaw Avenue.) Park in the lot at the back of the church, and enter through the main door near this lot. The meeting is on the lower level. There is a stairway and an elevator off the main lobby. Take the stairs or elevator to the lower level. Go left down the hallway; then go right down the next hallway. Our meeting is wheelchair accessible. There is a concurrent A.A. meeting in another room of the church.

Our meeting is a "barefoot" meeting, which is a discussion meeting where members share on whatever topic they wish to speak about. The topics we talk about include (but are not limited to) Al-Anon Adult Children issues. We have a "first Step" (beginners) meeting when people new to Al-Anon attend our meeting. Our group has a phone list. We hold a group conscience when there are business issues to discuss.
